“GROW” QUESTIONS

Use these questions in your community group time to dig deeper, discover how you can apply today's message to everyday life, and join the movement of the *Touch of Jesus*.

1. Read Galatians 5:19-26 together out loud, slow enough to soak in each line.
 - a. What is most encouraging to you about this passage?
 - b. What does it say about the relevance today of your Church/Gathering, and your Christian life?
2. How do you see this lifestyle displayed in the lives of early Christians in Acts 2:42-47?
 - a. How do you think this is related to what Paul tells Agrippa in Acts 26:29 when he says, "I pray that you and everyone listening would be what I am?"
 - b. Is it arrogant to think this way about one's way of life? Why or why not?
3. Back in Galatians 5, though none of these fruit of the Spirit are isolated unto themselves...
 - a. Which one to you most long to see around you?
 - b. Which one would you want to ask the Holy Spirit to most develop in you?
 - c. How can we help each other with living this way -- Since some of us gravitate and find one fruit more easily lived out than another (i.e. We all have different God-given personalities)?
4. So...do you think the Gathering started by Jesus is still relevant today?
5. After what we've seen, do you believe that *everybody still needs a touch from Jesus?*
